OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Sub.: Participation of CWC Officials as a Panel member of Dam safety Review Panels (DSRPs) to be constituted by various States/Central Agencies for dam safety inspections of various dams in the Country under new Dam Rehabilitation and Improvement Project Phase-II and III – regd.

The matter related to dam safety inspection is related to safety concerns of various dams linked with water security as well risk mitigation associated with these structures as well as public, property & environment d/s of these dams. Keeping in view, the past experience of CWC in the ongoing Dam Rehabilitation and Improvement Project (DRIP), wherein substantial time was taken during the preparatory phase of this Project and consequently physical and financial progress was adversely affected. Therefore, to ensure timely completion of preparatory activities of new DRIP Phase-II and Phase-III, the various State Governments as well as other Agencies which are part of this new Project, may avail the services of working CWC officials for availing the domain expertise in various categories to timely complete the dam safety inspections.

- 2. At the same time, this opportunity to CWC Officials may also help for expanding their over view regarding complex challenges in dam safety and will further help in enhancing the institutional strengthening of the organisation as well as. Also, CWC is already rendering project monitoring and appraisal support to various State Governments regarding their water resources projects. The services of CWC Officials in dam safety inspections may also be treated as an official support to various dam owners of the Country on the similar line. It has been approved by competent authority that CWC officials may participate as a member of DSRPs to be constituted by various State governments as well as Central agencies with following conditions.
 - i. The officials while on dam safety inspection may be treated on official duty and their TA/DA shall be borne by the concerned State/Central Agencies/dam owners, as the case may be. There shall be no financial implication to CWC in any way.
 - ii. A CWC officer, can take a maximum dam safety inspections of 20 numbers of dams in a year. If number of dam safety inspections is to be exceeded due to some justified reasons, prior approval of competent authority may be sought by the concerned official through proper channel and based on the merit of the case, competent authority may consider the case appropriately keeping in view various limitations.
 - iii. Each concerned official who proceeds on tour as part of Dam Safety Review Panel, may submit the soft copy of final DSRP Report to Chief Engineer, Dam Safety Organisation, CWC in order to create a pool of resources for institutional strengthening.
 - iv. Any honorarium to be taken by such officials shall be governed by the existing DoPT Circular no 17011/9/85-Estt (AL) dated 23.12.1985, 17020/1/91-Estt (AL) dated 18.11.1991 & 17011/3/97-Estt (AL) dated 17.07.1998 and Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure Order No. 19047/10/2016-E-IV dated 12.04.2017 and other relevant rule of Central Government from time to time, and it shall be the sole responsibility of the concerned officials for appropriate compliance of these rules accordingly.

The officials participating in DSRP may be restricted from working on rehabilitation activities of new DRIP Phase-II and Phase-III in CWC regarding those States/Agencies only for which officer has rendered the services as a member of DSRP, like examination of Project Screening Template, Third Party Construction Supervision and Quality Assurance etc. to avoid any conflict of interest.
