





Merger of CWC and GBWRO Ministerial Cadre	<p>CWC officers, present in the official side were requested to forward the status of GBWRO, i.e., whether it was a separate office which was merged with CWC along with copy of the order of merger. The CWC Officers were also requested to de-link the merger of GBWRO Cadre and Ministerial Cadre from the ongoing Cadre Review undertaken by the CWC and consider issuing the merger order, immediately, as conveyed during a meeting held with the Joint Secretary(Admn) of this Department on 16.08.2019.</p> <p>Action:- Central Water Commission</p>
	2.	Upgradation of Assistant to Administrative Officer.	<p>Central Water Commission has set up a Cadre Review(CR) Committee for Cadre Review. It was informed to CWC officers present in the official side that DoPT guidelines provides for consultation with all concerned stakeholders, which includes recognized Service Associations before finalizing the CR proposal. The Under Secretary(E-I), present in the official side was advised to forward a copy of relevant O.M. issued by the DoPT to the CWC.</p> <p>Action:- Central Water Commission</p>
	3.	Revival of Assistant Posts.	<p>Cadre Review Proposal for Ministerial Service has already been initiated by CWC. CWC officers present in the official side were requested to complete Cadre Review process as soon as possible.</p> <p>Action:- Central Water Commission</p>
	4.	Change of RRs of all Ministerial Cadre.	<p>Revision of Cadre Review is a regular exercise, which is to be done in every five years as per DOPT guidelines. CWC officers present in the official side informed that Cadre Review of Subordinate Service is presently initiated. Hence, any revision of RRs can be taken up after Cadre Review proposal is approved.</p> <p>Action:- Central Water Commission</p>
