Subject: Deputation of officers for Joint Hydrological Observation with Bangladesh during the lean season of 2021.

Sir,

In accordance with the provisions contained in the Treaty of sharing of Ganga Waters between India and Bangladesh signed in December, 1996, the Joint observations during the lean season of 2021 will commence from 1st January, 2021 and will end on 31st May, 2021. It is necessary to depute three teams of officers from Central Water Engineering Services to the observation site in Bangladesh viz, the Hardinge Bridge site on Ganga/ Padma in Bangladesh. Each team would consist of one Executive Engineer/ Deputy Director and one Assistant Executive Engineer/ Assistant Director/ Assistant Engineer/ Extra Assistant Director to be stationed at Bheramara near Hardinge Bridge in Bangladesh, for a period of about 55 days. The criterion of selection as decided by the Selection Committee are as under:

- (i) Officers who have put at least 3 years (up to 31st August in the year of application) in the actual hydrological observations of large rivers would only be considered.
- (ii) The experience at (CWC) Headquarters in the grade of J.E./EAD/A.D./DD would not be reckoned as field experience.
- (iii) Officers who had not been deputed earlier for the joint measurements at Hardinge Bridge (Bangladesh) would be given preference.
- (iv) Officers who have gone to a foreign country for a period more than 15 days during the last three years would not be considered, if otherwise qualified candidates are available.
- (v) The officers working in the Ministry of Jal Shakti, Department of Water Resources, RD&GR (at New Delhi) would be given priority, if they have worked for at least two years in the related field.

2. Based upon the nominations received latest up to 1st October 2020, the eligible officers would be called for personal interaction before the Selection Committee for ascertaining their overall suitability for the job.

3. In order to complete the selection process before 30th November, 2020, it is requested that the following dates may be strictly adhered to :

In view of the above, it is requested that the criterion for selection of officers for deputation to Harding Bridge (Bangladesh) may be widely circulated to DoWR, RD&GR, CWC and GFCC and nominations of suitable officers serving as Executive Engineers/Deputy Director/Deputy Commissioner, Assistant Executive Engineers/Assistant Director/ Assistant Commissioner/ Assistant Engineers/Extra Assistant Director may kindly be forwarded in the enclosed proforma (Annexure-I) by 01.10.2020. positively along with necessary vigilance clearance certificates. The Confidential Report Grading's No. (CR Dossiers) for the last five years of all the officers along with cadre clearance certificates shall also be sent by 07.10.2020. The terms and conditions for deputation to Bangladesh are enclosed as Annexure-II.

The nominations should have the concurrence of the Chairman, CWC.

49522/2020/TRNG DTE Terms and Conditions of Deputation of Officers
for Joint Discharge Observation in Bangladesh

1. Duration of Stay in Bangladesh:

Part or whole of the period of about five months from end of December to early June.

2. Nature of Duty:

Indo-Bangladesh Joint discharge observation on River Padma (Ganga) at Hardinge Bridge in Bangladesh under the supervision of designated Indian Official of the Ministry of Water Resources, RD&GR.

3.(a) Pay & Allowances:

The entire period of the Government servants' absence from his post in India will be treated as period of deputation on full pay and dearness allowances which he would have drawn, had he remained on duty in India.

(b) City Compensatory & House Rent Allowance:

The officers going abroad on deputation shall be eligible to draw compensatory (city) and house rent allowances for the entire period of deputation at the rates admissible to them from time to time at the station from where they processed abroad on deputation.

(c) Travelling allowances:

The officers will be entitled to travelling allowance in accordance with the following rates:

- (i) Within India: As per normal T.A. Rules.
- (ii) Outside India Air Journey: By Indian Airlines/Air India where it operates and in the class entitled to.

The excess baggage allowance over and above free allowance given by Air Company will be 5 kilos per passenger for carrying personal baggage.

Daily allowance

Rates of daily allowance will be those prescribed by the Ministry of External Affairs for the station in respect of officers of corresponding rank posted in Indian High Commission, Dhaka, as modified from time to time.

No other allowance will be admissible to him. In the case of enforced halts transit actual expenditure on board & lodging not exceeding the rate of daily allowance admissible at the place of halt would be admissible provided such facilities for boarding and lodging are not afforded by the Air Company.

For the purpose of these allowances, the period of deputation will include only the period of effective duty in Bangladesh where the official is deputed and will be deemed to commence on the date on which he arrives there and on the date on which he departs from there.
