INTRODUCTION:

North-Eastern region of India, consisting of eight states, accounts for about 35% of total water resources of the country whereas its geographical area is only 8% of the country. Rainfall of the region is high, which ranges from a minimum of 1000 mm to maximum of 11000mm. Cherrapunji-Mawphlang belt having rainfall over 11000 mm annually, is the highest in the world. The major river basins of the region are Brahmaputra basin, Barak basin, Gumti basin and Imphal basin. Out of these, Brahmaputra basin alone constitutes about 33% of the country's total surface water potential. Annual flow of Brahmaputra and Barak rivers, before entering into Bangladesh are 537.2BCM and 14.08BCM respectively which are the highest among all river basins in the country. The region is also facing severe problem of floods drainage congestion and erosion of the riverbanks. Flood events lead to bankline or surface soil erosion or deposition of sediments. There are deposition in prominent sites of the river and gradual erosion at other parts of the river leading to change of river course or making human settlement into highly susceptible to the erosion problems. Thus estimate of flood flow is required for taking precautionary measures and also design of hydraulic structures. Due consideration should be given to the design of the structure so as to prevent it from collapsing and causing further damage due to flood.
