**Minutes of the Video Conference (V.C.) meeting held on 24.11.2021 to review
status of Pending Pension cases under regional offices of CWC.**

A Video Conference (V.C.) meeting under the Chairmanship of Chairman, CWC was held on 24.11.2021 in Committee room 2nd Floor (South), Sewa Bhawan, Central Water Commission, New Delhi to review the status of Pending Pension cases under regional offices. The list of officers attended the meeting in person is at **Annexure-1**. In addition officers from field offices participated in the meeting through Video Conference.

At the outset, Chairman, CWC welcomed all the participants. Secretary, CWC appraised various grievances on long pending pension cases of work charged establishment of CWC and briefed on pending pension cases as received from DDOs. Chairman, CWC expressed his concern on large pendency of pension cases in CWC. He emphasized to resolve all the pending pension cases in a time bound manner and not to keep any case pending either at Division level or at PAO level. Based on the deliberations held during the meeting the following decisions emerged:

1. Chairman, CWC emphasized that the officers from field offices and PAO sit together and resolve all pending pension cases within a month time. The concerned DDOs shall send their representatives to PAO office with full preparation and sufficient time to resolve the cases efficiently. PAO shall give due priority to these pending cases.
(Action: PAO/ DDOs)
- ✓ 2. As far as possible, Service Book of the pensioners shall not be sent back to division offices unless all the retirement benefits are paid. If required, scan copy of requisite pages of Service Books may be sent to DDOs.
(Action: PAO/ E-IV/e-Gov Cell)
- ✓ 3. After the Payment of LE and CGEGIS, Establishment-IV shall intimate the concern DDOs/ EEs by email to depute an official from division office to collect the Service Books from Establishment-IV Section.
(Action: E-IV/ DDOs)
4. PAO, CWC advised that details regarding Terminal Benefits i.e. Gratuity, Leave encashment, CGEGIS, DCRG, etc. be got checked by AAO, Division Office before sending to PAO, CWC. Further, any advice on Administrative matters in pension cases may be taken from concern Establishment Section of CWC.
(Action: DDOs)
5. Grievance cases related to pension matters pending at CPGRAM Portal shall be treated as very urgent and the Superintending Engineer (Coordination) of respective field organisation & PAO, CWC shall update their remarks/ status on CPGRAM Portal timely and convey the same to the petitioner.
(Action: SEs (C)/ PAO)

Sub: Pending DCRG and other cases of Seasonal Khalasis who already retired from service – Regarding.


Sir,

Kindly refer our telephonic conversation on 17.01.2022 regarding above subjected matter. You informed that the pension cases of Seasonal Khalasis already cleared and there is no pending case available with CWC.

- 2 On contacting the concerned official at PAO (Pension), same information was received. Altogether, some 165 cases pending with the PAO (Pension) for want of some clarifications and it ascertained that the clarifications already received and the cases will be cleared as soon as possible.
- 3 *On enquiry with reliable sources it is understood that the cases were cleared and all the cases along with Service Books are with Estt.IV for dispatching to the field offices. Due to Covid-19, neither the field offices are sending any special messenger to CWC HQ for collecting the Service Books, nor Estt.IV taking necessary action to send it by post or courier to the Division offices.*
4. The retired Seasonal Khalasis rendered many number of years of service for CWC but they are retired without getting any pension or retirement benefits due to lack of eligible service of 10 years because CWC gave them appointment orders for 4 to 6 months in a year during monsoon season.
5. Whatever the benefits they are eligible to get are denied due to the avoidable delays of these kind as explained above, particularly through Para 3 of this letter. Without any retirement benefits, these Seasonal Khalasis were put into a doleful circumstances. They are at the verge of starving and knackered.
6. A few names from Upper Godavari Division and Lower Godavari Division, Hyderabad is enclosed herewith. Pan India, there are lot of cases pending which are to be looked into on priority basis.
7. Necessary and immediate action is highly anticipated in this issue so that theses affected Seasonal Khalasis can come out from their appalling life and get some respite. There are Seasonal Khalasis who are expired while in service and their family pension cases also pending. A lot other Seasonal Khalasis expired after their retirement and their families are at cross roads.

The above are the ground reality. Be mercy up on these unfortunate ex-Central Govt. employees by dispatching their Service Books with the finalized orders so that they can get some respite please.
