Naidu demands ₹3,715 crore Polavaram dues from Centre

Guinness record created at site of irrigation project

APPAJI REDDEM POLAVARAM

Buoyed by the record-breaking feat by the Navayuga Engineering Company Limited (NECL) at the Polavaram multipurpose irrigation site where it found a place in the Guinness Book of World Records for the highest usage of concrete, 32,315.5 cubic metres within 24 hours, Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu on Monday asked the company to break its own record in three months.

He demanded that the Centre release ₹3,715 crore dues related to the project at the earliest. Announcing the record at a press meet at the project site, Mr. Naidu said, "We have gone far ahead of Indian expectations. I want Navayuga to break its own record in March by filling in 65,000 cubic metres concrete within 24 hours."

The company on Monday broke an earlier feat, where

21,580 cubic metres was poured in a hotel project by Abdul Wahed bin Shabib RALS Contracting LLC and Alfa Engg. Consultant in Dubai.

On the progress of the project, the Chief Minister said the cost, along with the Relief and Rehabilitation, was \$58,000 crore as per the revised estimates.

About 7,000 MT of cement, 3,000 workers and 225 engineers, besides 90 transit

mixers, five telebelts, four book placers and 20 agitator trucks delivering concrete from three batching plants of 240 cubic metres per hour capacity and seven plants of 120 cubic metres per hour capacity were involved in the task, as per Navayuga.

The company was planning to complete the construction of the spillway and two coffer dams by June, NECL managing director C. Sridhar said.



dispose thermocol cups and other such items instead of burning them.

Water quality

Reiterating previous orders passed by it, the green panel said, "We direct that earlier direction of digitally displaying water quality at permanent places may be fully complied with during the Kumbh Mela."

The directions came while the NGT took note of a re-

port submitted by a committee constituted by it earlier, which highlighted measures for waste management to be undertaken during the event.

The NGT noted the Kumbh Sanitation Plan provided by the Health Department and Mela Authority to the committee.

"The Kumbh Sanitation Plan provides for three coloured bins for storage of bio-degradable waste, recyclable waste and other wastes. It was noted that there is a requirement of centres for collection and segregation of waste and also for public association and awareness and community mobilisation...the Ministry of Urban Development and Housing and other authorities should display posters and banners to educate the people with regard to waste management," the Bench observed.
